

### **BCCE Contract Says...**

#### 1.1 Purpose

The purpose of this Agreement is to promote the improvement of unit member/District relations, to provide an equitable procedure for the resolution of differences, and to establish rates of pay and other terms and conditions of employment.

#### 15.4 Right to Union Representation

A unit member shall be notified at the time a meeting is scheduled which may result in disciplinary action of the subject of that meeting and of his/her right to Union representation. A meeting shall be scheduled or rescheduled to accommodate a unit member's right to representation as soon as practicable after notice of the meeting, and no longer than five (5) working days following such notice, notwithstanding mutual waiver of the time limit.

No unit member shall be expected to respond to allegations which may lead to disciplinary action if the above procedures have not been followed, nor shall the District take punitive action against any unit member for exercising his/her rights under this section.
